RESOLUTION 12-08

A Resolution establishing criteria for the issuance of bar and grill licenses.

Whereas it is desirable to establish criteria for the issuance of bar and grill licenses to be submitted by applicants prior to consideration for issuance of the licenses.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERIDAN:

1. That the City Council may consider the following criteria to be submitted by applicants prior to considering the issuance of bar and grill licenses:

a. A business plan of the restaurant including but not limited to:

- (1) Location,
- (2) Whether the license will be used to attract other businesses,
- (3) Renovation of historic buildings,
- (4) Create a business anchor,
- (5) Hours of operation,
- (6) Customer offerings,
- (7) Building design, and
- (8) Franchise or chain affiliation;

b. Three years of financial projections with cash flow, profit and loss statements and balance sheets;

c. The potential increase in employment of employees to the restaurant should the restaurant be issued the bar and grill license;

d. The potential increase to the restaurant's total aggregate payroll should the restaurant be issued the bar and grill license;


e. Whether location of the restaurant meets current zoning requirements and whether the welfare of the citizens residing in the vicinity of proposed license would be impacted; and,

f. Any other documents or information that may be beneficial to City Council in the issuance of the bar and grill license.


g. Demonstration of ongoing program for TIPS, CARES or "serve safe" or equivalent training and certification for their employees.
